**Entry:** All vehicles are to enter via the Trade entrance (see map on last page)

## Access times:

### Friday April 4th, 2025

- Fair volunteers will be onsite from 8.30am - 8.00pm to help you find your trade space and/or campsite.
- The indoor Hall area will be open 8.30am - 6.00pm for traders to setup.
- Security will be onsite overnight from 6.00pm

### Saturday April 5th, 2025

- Fair volunteers will be onsite from 7.00am.
- The indoor Hall area will be open from 7.30am.
- Vehicles used for loading must be offsite by 9.30am SHARP!
- Gates open to patrons at 10.00am, and close at 4.00pm.
- Vehicles may re-enter the site after 4.30pm and no earlier.
- Security will remain onsite overnight.

### Sunday April 6th, 2025

- Fair volunteers will be onsite from 8.00am.
- The indoor Hall area will be open from 8.00am.
- Vehicles used for loading must be offsite by 9.30am SHARP!
- Gates open to patrons at 10.00am, and close at 4.00pm.
- Vehicles may re-enter the site after 4.30pm and no earlier.

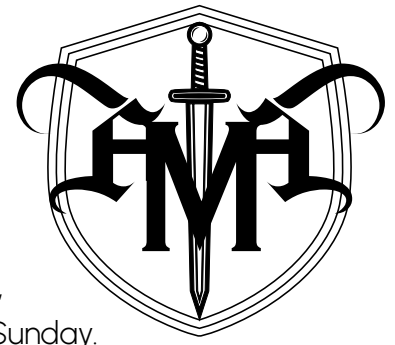
### Monday April 7th, 2025

- Fair volunteers will be onsite from 8.30am - 1.00pm
- The indoor Hall area will be open from 8.30am.
- The camping and trade areas must be vacated by 12.00pm.

**ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM SITE BY 9.30AM ON SATURDAY & SUNDAY.**

Our volunteers will be in high-vis vests during bump-in times. Please ask us for help finding your site. All sites will have numbers marked on the grass/hall floor.



## Parking & Vehicle movement

Traders are asked to park at the northern end of the car park  
(*new location: refer to map*).

The car park will be staffed by the local Royal Flying Doctors volunteers.  
Parking will be a gold coin donation between 9 am - 2 pm Saturday & Sunday.  
Entry to the grounds can then be made via foot through the main gate.

## Friday night welcome sausage sizzle

We have a designated camping space for traders, please see the map (last page).

The Showgrounds camping space includes access to hot showers and toilet blocks. Electricity is also available. 2025 camping pricing is \$40 per night (up to 4 people on one site). Camping sites are 7m x 7m and includes access to electricity.

The stallholder must hold and provide a copy of their Certificate of Currency (Public and Product Liability) for an amount not less than \$10,000,000. (See item 4, terms and conditions of your application form).

Please be reminded that service animals must be wearing the appropriate identifying harness or collar. Pets must be contained within your camping area during the event (10am-4pm Saturday and Sunday). Please be respectful of other traders and patrons and pick up after your animal.

## Treasure Scroll Map

We invite all traders to participate in our Fantasy Medieval Fair Treasure Scroll Map.

There is no fee to be involved.

Patrons at the Fair purchase a Treasure Scroll and then make their way through the fairgrounds to have their maps ticked off by participating traders and entertainers. Once completed the participant returns their map to the Info stand and receives a small treasure.

The 2024 traders involved all gave us great feedback - each participating stall will be provided with an identifying sign (A4 size or smaller). Traders are provided with a stamp and/or texta to mark off maps. It is at the traders' discretion if they provide the participants with a "treasure" along the way. 2024 treasures included stickers, wooden tags, cookies, 3D printed coins. This is at the traders' expense.

The purpose of the Treasure Scroll Map is to encourage fair-goers to experience all the areas of the grounds and seek out traders and entertainers they may not have otherwise seen.

Inclusion in the Treasure Scroll Map is at the organizers' discretion.
